**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, STRAINER, BRUNO, DIAMOND, PATCHETT, NILES AND BEATY**

**AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH LOG JAM OF GLENS FALLS, INC. (THE LOG JAM RESTAURANT) FOR THE CREATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FLOWER/POLLINATOR/SHRUB GARDEN AT THE WARREN COUNTY BIKE PATH**

WHEREAS, Warren County owns and maintains the Warren County Bike Path for public recreational use, and

WHEREAS, the Log Jam Restaurant has expressed interest in beautifying and maintaining a portion of the Warren County Bike Path, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public Works requested, and the Public Works Committee agreed, to enter into an agreement with Log Jam of Glens Falls, Inc., at no cost to the County, for the creation and maintenance of a flower/pollinator/shrub garden at the entrance of the Warren County Bike Path located near the bike off-ramp at the Factory Outlets near the intersection of State Route 149 and State Route 9 in Lake George, New York, for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with Log Jam of Glens Falls, Inc., 1484 State Route 9, Lake George, New York 12845, at no cost to the County, for the creation and maintenance of a flower/pollinator/shrub garden at the entrance of the Warren County Bike Path located near the bike off-ramp at the Factory Outlets near the intersection of State Route 149 and State Route 9 in Lake George, New York, for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
