### RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS RUNYON AND STRAINER

**WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN A RESOLUTION REGARDING A HOME RULE REQUEST BY WARREN COUNTY FOR THE ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL NO. S9128 AND ASSEMBLY BILL NO. A10373 ENTITLED "AN ACT IN RELATION TO AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF WARREN TO OFFER AN OPTIONAL TWENTY-YEAR RETIREMENT PLAN TO BRADLEY MURPHY, A PATROL OFFICER EMPLOYED BY SUCH COUNTY"**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1 of 2026, and subsequently amended by Resolution No. 76 of 2026, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section B(4) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider a resolution regarding a Home Rule Request by Warren County for the enactment of Senate Bill No. S9128 and Assembly Bill No. A10373 Entitled "An Act in Relation to Authorizing the County of Warren to Offer an Optional Twenty-year Retirement Plan to Bradley Murphy, a Patrol Officer Employed by Such County", now, therefore, be it
