

- ❖ **Memorial Meltdown (Dave Ehmann):** Dave will be doing Memorial Meltdown on Memorial Day weekend. They will be leaving the same day that Americade comes in. As of February 3, 2026, I have not received an application from Dave yet. I will send a reminder email to Dave to indicate we need a Wood Park application for him to use the park for his event. **We need to make sure we have more guys on (whether it be from the County or with the Village) to help our park groundskeeper, Dave Goodsell.**
- ❖ **Hudson Valley Firemen’s Convention (Matt Oswald):** Came in on February 3, 2026, and asked for new occupancy tax paperwork. **They will not be using Wood Park.**
- ❖ **Adirondack Jeep Invasion (Jamie Longmuir):** Heard from Jamie via email on December 10, 2025, saying that they were planning to come back for June 19 – 21, 2026. However, they may change venues. They have the permits filled out but is holding off on submitting until they hear from Kevin Hajos about the newly vacated Warren County fairgrounds.
- ❖ **Schott’s Boxing (Rick):** Rick emailed me on January 21, 2026, saying that **they were not going to use Wood Park** as they found an indoor venue.
- ❖ **Adirondack Independence Music Festival (Dave Ehmann):** Dave will be doing Adirondack Independence Music Festival on Labor Day weekend (September 4-6, 2026). As of February 3, 2026, I have not received an application from Dave yet. I will send a reminder email to Dave to indicate we need a Wood Park application for him to use the park for his event.
- ❖ **Adirondack Nationals Car Show (Erin VanVeghten & Ken Williams):** Erin VanVeghten asked me via email on January 27, 2026, for the Village occupancy tax application with budget sheet, the Wood Park application with aerial view, and the Lake George Special Event application. I sent it all to her on January 28, 2026. As of February 3, 2026, no application yet.
- ❖ **Moon Glow (Mayor Ray Perry):** Mayor Perry is working to bring back this event. I asked for the date on December 5, and he said September 18, 2026. Details are being worked up before an application is submitted to the County / Village Board. **No updates.**
- ❖ **Tunnels to Towers 5K (Maria Muldner):** Maria Muldner sent me an email on January 27, 2026, asking for the Wood Park application and the Village occupancy tax application. I sent it all to her via email on January 28, 2026. I then notified her if she would like to be on the February meeting agenda, she must submit it by February 4, 2026. As of February 3, 2026, no application yet.
- ❖ **Unknown Event:** Staci called on November 25, 2025, wanting to know if September 17 – 19, 2025 was available. I told her it was and that she would need to submit an application. Please note this was before Moon Glow was mentioned. An email was sent to her with application on November 30. I have no idea if this is for the Moon Glow or something else entirely. **No updates.**

- ✧ **Unknown Event:** Sheila called on January 15, 2026, wanting to start an event in the Village. She is interested in doing a food truck event. I told her that Charles R. Wood Park is available. I sent her an email on January 15, 2026, reminding her of what we talked about and providing her with the Wood Park application.
- ✧ **Wolfsgart Euro Car:** Anthony called on December 15, 2025, wanting to bring this event from Burlington Vermont to here. Both the Mayor and I chatted with him, and the Mayor told him he should set up in Wood Park. The Mayor and Anthony are talking still, and the approximate dates are August 6-9, 2026.
- ✧ **Camping Event:** Michael called on January 15, 2026, wanting to inquire about open spaces in the Village in case the battlefield is denied (working with DEC). The event sounded like it was similar to the Pilgrimage in regard to camping, so I offered him Wood Park. I told him to keep us updated if the battlefield is a no-go. I then told him I would follow back up with him if the Mayor had any other suggestions for places in case Wood Park can't hold 200 students. As of February 3, 2026, I haven't heard anything from the applicant.
