Program Name: Crimes Against Revenue Program (CARP)

Program Description: Projects funded under CARP involve the investigation and prosecution of financial crimes that wrongfully deprive the state of revenue or involve fraudulent benefit claims. CARP cases include tax cases as well as cases of fraud involving Medicaid, welfare, prevailing wages, unemployment insurance, and workers' compensation. Successful investigations and prosecutions allow the state to recoup funds through restitution, fines and penalties - monetary sanctions obtained in addition to, or in lieu of, a sentence of incarceration.

Program Name: Aid to Prosecution

Program Description: This program provides vital resources to district attorneys in all New York State counties to support the enhanced prosecution of repeat, violent and serious felony offenders. The program promotes vertical prosecution, where a prosecutor can oversee a case from intake through its conclusion.
