UPDATING WARREN COUNTY'S POLICY FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO MAY BE CALLED TO DUTY WITH RESPECT TO ANY FUTURE LOCAL, NATIONAL OR GLOBAL CRISIS

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 636 of 2001 was enacted to establish a policy to protect Warren County employees from loss of benefits while serving as members of an Armed Forces Reserves or National Guard, as a result of the September 11, 2001 attacks, and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Personnel Officer has recommended, and the Finance Committee approved, the updating of the policy established by Resolution No. 636 of 2001 to cover any future local, national or global crisis that may arise, in order to protect County employees from the loss of benefits while serving as members of an Armed Forces Reserves or National Guard, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the policy for County employees who may be called to duty and serve as members of an Armed Forces Reserves or National Guard, be and hereby is, updated to include any local, national or global crises.
