ADOPTING AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLAN, AN ADA POLICY,
DISCRIMINATION/GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE AND TO BECOME A SIGNATORY TO
THE NEW YORK STATE DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Office of Equal Opportunity and Development and Compliance, State of
New York - Department of Transportation requires that Warren County comply with Federal Title
VI Assurance, and

WHEREAS, Warren County will implement an Affirmative Action Program in accordance
with Federal and State requirements, and

WHEREAS, Warren County will comply with the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act
of July 26, 1992, and

WHEREAS, Warren County will agree to comply with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations,
Part 23,41 by becoming a signatory to New York State Department of Transportation, Disadvantaged
Business Enterprise (DBE) Plan, and

WHEREAS, Warren County will have a discrimination/grievance procedure in place, now,
therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works or a designated
official or representative is hereby designated to implement and enforce the above-referenced
program/procedures, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works or a designated
official or representative shall be assigned to administer the requirements of this plan.
