RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS MADAY, CONOVER, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL, BUTLER AND O'NEILL

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH CUMMINS-WAGNER HOLDINGS, INC. D/B/A CUMMINS-WAGNER-SIEWERT, LLC D/B/A SIEWERT EQUIPMENT TO PROVIDE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE AND ON-SITE INSPECTION OF SEPTIC LIFT STATION (PUMPS) AND MUFFIN MONSTER (GRINDER) SYSTEM FOR THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requested, and the Criminal Justice, Public Safety & Emergency Services Committee agreed, to enter into an agreement with Cummins-Wagner Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Cummins-Wagner-Siewert, LLC d/b/a Siewert Equipment in an amount not to exceed Twenty-One Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$21,676) to provide preventative maintenance and on-site inspection of septic lift station (pumps) and muffin monster (grinder) system for the Warren County Sheriff's Office, for a term commencing August 1, 2026 and terminating July 31, 2031, to be paid as follows:

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to enter into an agreement with Cummins-Wagner Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Cummins-Wagner-Siewert, LLC d/b/a Siewert Equipment, 175 Akron Street, Rochester, New York 14609, to provide preventative maintenance and on-site inspection of septic lift station (pumps) and muffin monster (grinder) system for the Warren County Sheriff's Office, as described in the preambles of this resolution, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for said agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.3110 470, Sheriff's Law Enforcement, Contract.
