RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS DRISCOLL, GILLIGAN, TURNER, WILD, STRAINER, O'NEILL AND GOODSPEED

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 503 OF 2025, WHICH AUTHORIZED AN AGREEMENT WITH YOUTH ADVOCATE PROGRAMS, INC. TO PROVIDE MENTAL HEALTH, SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND IN-HOME PARENTING SKILL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO HIGH RISK YOUTH FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 503 of 2025, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc., for an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) to provide mental health, substance abuse and in-home parenting skill programs and services to high risk youth over a term commencing January 1, 2026 and terminating December 31, 2026, with the option for two (2) additional one (1) year terms upon the same terms and conditions and upon mutual agreement of the parties, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requested and the Human Services Committee agreed to rescind Resolution No. 503 of 2025 due to the fact that the Commissioner of Social Services decided to contract with WAIT House instead of Youth Advocate Programs, Inc., now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby rescinds Resolution No. 503 of 2025.
