RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GILLIGAN, STROUGH, TURNER, DRISCOLL, STRAINER, MADAY AND ETU

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 487 OF 2019, AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH REVERUS CORPORATION FOR NETWORK CONSULTING AND PROGRAMMING SERVICES, TO REMOVE THE HOURLY RATE AND INCREASE THE NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 487 of 2019, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized an agreement (previously authorized by Resolution No. 132 of 2015) with Reverus Corporation to provide network consulting and programming services, in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) per year, with an hourly rate of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150), for a term commencing upon execution by both parties, allowing for automatic annual renewals upon the same terms and conditions provided the funding is budgeted and terminating for convenience with forty-five (45) days written notice, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Information Technology requested, and the Support Services Committee agreed, to amend the agreement to increase the not to exceed amount from Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) per year to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) per year and to remove the hourly rate of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150), now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with Reverus Corporation, 855 Route 146, Suite 170, Clifton Park, New York 12065, to increase the not to exceed amount to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) per year and remove the hourly rate of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150), for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and terminating upon forty-five (45) days written notice by either party, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution Nos. 132 of 2015 and 487 of 2019 will remain the same.
