RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS MADAY, CONOVER, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL, BUTLER AND O'NEILL

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 96 OF 2025, WHICH AUTHORIZED AN AGREEMENT WITH P.S. TECHNOLOGIES, INC. D/B/A LEGALSERVER FOR THE PURCHASE AND SUBSCRIPTION FOR A CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE, TO INCREASE THE SUBSCRIPTION FEE AND INCLUDE ANNUAL RENEWALS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 96 of 2025, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized an agreement with P.S. Technologies, Inc. d/b/a LegalServer, for the purchase and subscription for a case management program for the Warren County Public Defender's Office, for a one-time set up fee of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$48,900), with an onboarding start date of May 5, 2025 and with a subscription fee of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) per month and a cloud hosting fee of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per month, for a total amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$16,800) for enhanced onboarding and subscription fees over a term commencing April 1, 2025 and terminating December 31, 2026, and

WHEREAS, the Public Defender requested, and the Criminal Justice, Public Safety & Emergency Services Committee agreed, to amend the agreement to increase the subscription fee from Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) per month to Six Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$618) per month, for a term commencing January 1, 2026 and terminating January 31, 2027, with annual renewals, provided the subscription fee increases do not exceed 3% annually, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with P.S. Technologies, Inc. d/b/a LegalServer, P.O. Box 221154, Chicago, Illinois 60622, as described in the preambles of this resolution, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 96 of 2025 will remain the same.
