Proclamation

WHEREAS, the development of vaccines has been one of the most important public health achievements of the past century in preventing disease and increasing life expectancy, and

WHEREAS, National Immunization Awareness Month (NIAM) is an annual observance held in August to highlight the importance of vaccination for people of all ages, and

WHEREAS, each year, as many as 50,000 U.S. residents die from diseases that are preventable through timely vaccination, while immunization prevents an estimated 4 million deaths worldwide annually, and

WHEREAS, vaccines have demonstrated to be an exceptionally safe method to prevent disease, but community rates must remain high to prevent the re-emergence of diseases, and

WHEREAS, Warren County Health Services is integrally involved in working to ensure that all Warren County residents have easy access to immunization services and information related to immunization, holding at least four clinics per month at Warren County Municipal Center this year while continuing educational outreach as well, and

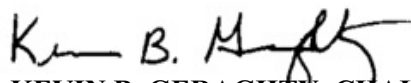
WHEREAS, our local medical providers and NY State and Federal agencies have been valued partners in the provision of immunization services to Warren County residents, now, therefore, be it
