RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS MADAY, CONOVER, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL, BUTLER AND O'NEILL

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOLTON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AT THE BOLTON CENTRAL SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Bolton Central School District ("School") has requested that the Warren County Sheriff provide law enforcement services by providing coverage equal to one (1) School Resource Officer in the form of either a Patrol Officer, Patrol Officer - Part Time, or a Special Patrol Officer, as determined by the Sheriff, at the Bolton Central School for the 2026-2027 academic year, commencing August 24, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has agreed to provide these services during normal school hours throughout the 2026-2027 academic year and for such other school events that may be requested by the School District and covered under the terms of the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the School has agreed to pay the County an amount not to exceed Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) for such School Resource Officer services to the Bolton Central School over a term commencing August 24, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to enter into an agreement with the Bolton Central School District, 26 Horicon Avenue, Bolton Landing, New York 12814 in an amount not to exceed Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) to provide law enforcement services during normal school hours for the 2026-2027 academic year and for such other events as may be requested by the School District over a term commencing August 24, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
