RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS WILD, CROCITTO, BRUNO, PATCHETT, DIAMOND, BEATY AND NILES

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON-SARATOGA-WARREN-HAMILTON-ESSEX BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (BOCES) FOR YOUTH EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM SERVICES FOR THE WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM AND TO PREPARE YOUTH FOR THE TEST ASSESSING SECONDARY COMPLETION (TASC) HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY ASSESSMENT TO YOUTH AGED 16-24 IN WARREN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Director of Workforce Development requested, and the Economic Growth & Development Committee agreed, to enter into an agreement with the Washington-Saratoga-Warren-Hamilton-Essex Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) in an amount not to exceed Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$21,421), to provide youth employment program services for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Youth Employment Program and to prepare Youth for the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC) High School Equivalency Assessment to youth aged 16-24 in Warren County, for a term commencing September 10, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with the Washington-Saratoga-Warren-Hamilton-Essex Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES), 267 Ballard Road, Suite 7, Wilton, New York 12831, in an amount not to exceed Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$21,421) to provide youth employment program services for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Youth Employment Program and to prepare Youth for the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC) High School Equivalency Assessment to youth aged 16-24 in Warren County, for a term commencing September 10, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for this agreement shall be expended from the appropriate departmental budget codes.
