RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS RUNYON AND STRAINER

WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN A RESOLUTION INTRODUCING PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2026, ENTITLED “A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, CREATING THE POSITION OF COMMISSIONER OF FINANCE, PRESERVING THE STATUTORY AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY TREASURER, AND REPEALING LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1969”, AND AUTHORIZING PUBLIC HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1 of 2026, and subsequently amended by Resolution Nos. 76 of 2026 and 239 of 2026, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section B(4) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider a resolution introducing Proposed Local Law No. 7 of 2026, entitled “A Local Law Establishing a Department of Finance, Creating the Position of Commissioner of Finance, Preserving the Statutory Authority of the County Treasurer, and Repealing Local Law No. 4 of 1969, and Authorizing Public Hearing Thereon”, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive the Standing Rule of the Board relating to the requirements that all resolutions be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board meeting in order to entertain the aforementioned resolution.
