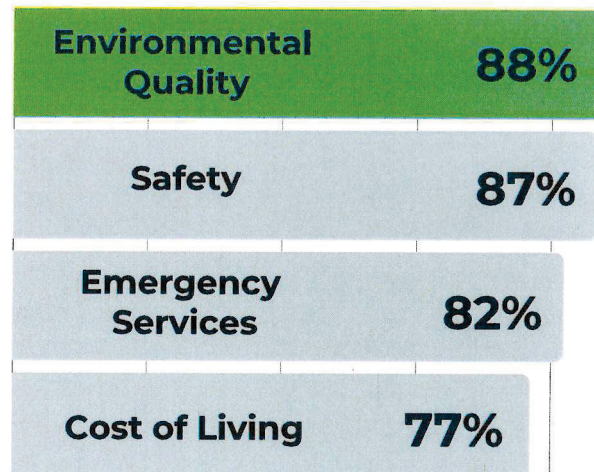

REQUEST FOR FUNDING- 2026

Program Highlights

- Warren County Soil and Water requests \$10,000 in funding for the WC Water Quality Monitoring Program’s 2026 field season. The funding will expand the monitoring program to additional waterbodies throughout the County, including Brant Lake and Southern Schroon Lake.
- The Water Quality Monitoring Program currently serves waterbodies in Warren County including Lake Luzerne, Loon Lake, and Friends Lake. Sampling is typically conducted from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Warren County Soil and Water conducts the sampling and partners with SUNY Adirondack for the lab testing.
- Lakes associations throughout the County have expressed interest in access to Warren County Soil and Water resources to establish a water quality monitoring program. The additional funding will allow Warren County Soil and Water to hire an intern to conduct sampling on additional waterbodies interested in joining the program and to obtain necessary supplies and materials.
