Mr. Crocitto called the meeting of the Park Operations & Management (O&M) Committee to order at 10:18 a.m.

Motion was made by Mr. Bruno, seconded by Mr. Niles and carried unanimously to approve the minutes of the previous Committee meeting, subject to correction by the Clerk of the Board.

Mr. Crocitto apprised the Committee had a new member; John Helms, who replaced Keith Lanfear, *Superintendent of Public Works*, and he welcomed Mr. Helms.

Privilege of the floor and public comments were called for, but there was no one wishing to speak.

The Committee commenced with a review of the Discussion Items portion of the agenda, which included the following item:

1. Festival Space update.

Privilege of the floor was extended to Kevin Hajos, *Superintendent of Public Works*, who informed Mr. Helms had worked under Mr. Lanfear for many years adding, if Mr. Lanfear was not available Mr. Hajos was always able to reach Mr. Helms and he stated the two had a good work relationship. Mr. Hajos congratulated Mr. Helms and welcomed him.
