RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CROCITTO, WILD, STROUGH, TURNER, RUNYON, BUTLER AND PATCHETT

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH QUEENSBURY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, INC. FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THE 2025 ADIRONDACK HOT AIR BALLOON FESTIVAL AT THE WARREN COUNTY (FLOYD BENNETT MEMORIAL) AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the Tourism Director requested, and the Occupancy Tax Coordination Committee agreed, to enter into an agreement with Queensbury Emergency Medical Services, Inc. to provide reimbursement for expenses incurred during the 2025 Adirondack Hot Air Balloon Festival at the Warren County (Floyd Bennett Memorial) Airport, and

WHEREAS, Queensbury Emergency Medical Services, Inc. has delivered to the Tourism Director an accounting of expenses incurred during the 2025 Adirondack Hot Air Balloon Festival, reflecting a total cost of Three Thousand Five Hundred Three Dollars and Seven Cents (\$3,503.07), now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with Queensbury Emergency Medical Services, Inc. for reimbursement of expenses incurred during the 2025 Adirondack Hot Air Balloon Festival, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement will commence September 19, 2025 and terminate upon payment of an invoice from Queensbury Emergency Medical Services, Inc. for an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Three Dollars and Seven Cents (\$3,503.07), and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for this invoice will be expended from Budget Code A.6417.0002 480, Tourism/Occupancy, Occupancy Tax, Tourism-Special Events.
